TASK ORDER NAME: 2024 General Engineering and Maintenance

This is Task Order No. 24-003 to the On Call Maintenance Contract entered into by and between Utah Transit Authority (UTA) and Rocky Mountain Systems Services, (Contractor) as of February 24th, 2021.

1.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES

2.0 SCHEDULE

The Substantial Completion Date for this Task is October 31, 2024. The Final Acceptance Date for this Task is October 31, 2024.

3.0 LUMP SUM PRICE

The price for this task order is a not to exceed \$300,000. Invoices will be billed on monthly basis for work completed to date.

4.0 APPLICABILITY OF FEDERAL CLAUSES

This Task Order does does not [Check Applicable] include federal assistance funds which requires the application of the Federal Clauses appended as Exhibit D to the On Call Maintenance Contract.

Dean,

Rocky Mountain Systems Services (RMSS) currently provides general engineering and field maintenance services on a time and material basis under Task Order #24-003 of the Systems On-call Services contract. This task order is anticipated to be utilized extensively from January 1st, 2024 to October 31st, 2024. During this duration of time for this task order RMSS will be flexible and will have rapid response time for urgent items that need immediate attention.

The total not to exceed (NTE) amount for this proposal will be **\$300,000.00**.

The scope of work in this proposal covers the following on a T&M basis:

- emergency callouts
- minor software and hardware engineering
- minor field maintenance / upgrades
- minor material purchases

This amount is being established to provide general engineering and maintenance support for approximately ten (10) months. Future items that fall under this task order are mostly unknown and difficult to quantify before the need arises.

Assumptions

- RMSS will bill UTA based on the attached 2024 T&M Labor Rate Sheet
 - T&M rates include a 12.5% fee
 - T&M rates include an additional 1% for insurance costs
 - T&M equipment rates are based on blue book values
- Material, subcontractor, and other costs not included on the rate sheet will be billed at cost with 12.5% fee and 1% insurance included
- RMSS will provide a separate proposal for any scope that is not to be billed against this NTE task order and is not already covered under another existing task order
- RMSS assumes that no bond will be required for any T&M work under this task order
