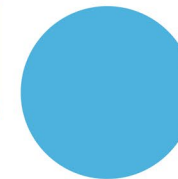


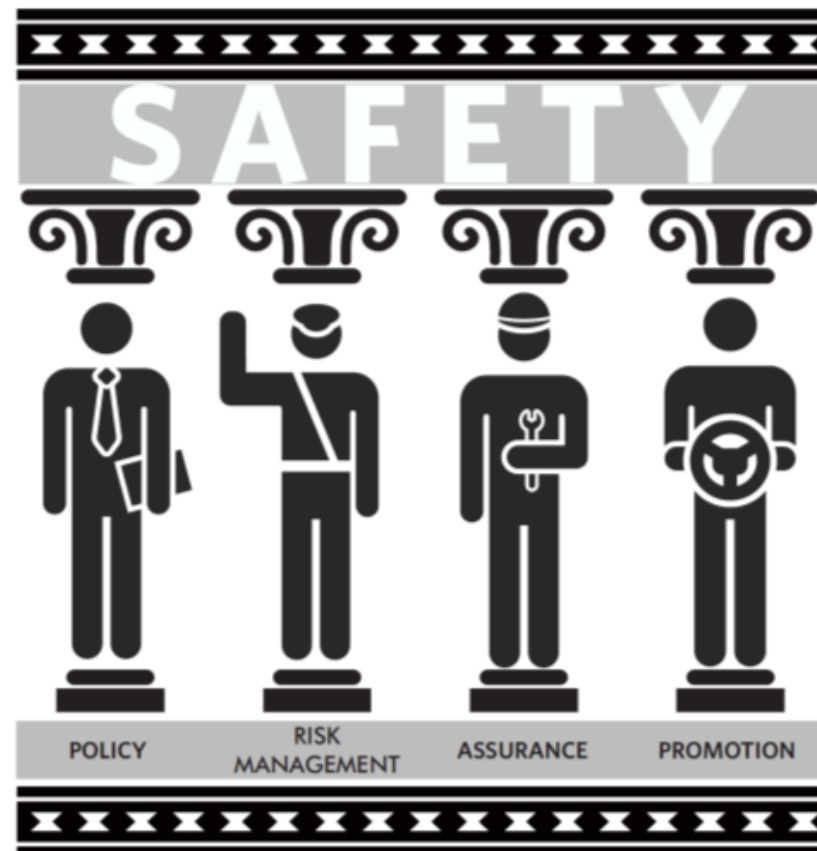

49 CFR Part 673

- ▶ General Requirements for Public Transportation Agency Safety Plan (PTASP)
- ▶ A process and timeline for conducting an annual review and update of the safety plan
- ▶ The designation of a Chief Safety Officer
- ▶ The documented processes of the agency's Safety Mgt System (SMS), including the agency's Safety Management Policy and processes for Safety Risk Management, Safety Assurance, and Safety Promotion
- ▶ An employee reporting program
- ▶ Performance targets based on the safety performance measures established in FTA's National Public Transportation Safety Plan (NSP)

Who approves a Safety Plan

- ▶ Must be approved by a Joint Labor Management Safety Committee.
- ▶ Must be signed by the Agency's Accountable Executive.
- ▶ Must be approved by its Board of Directors or an equivalent authority (such as a mayor, county executive, commission, or grant manager)
- ▶ State Safety Oversight Agencies (SSOAs) must approve the safety plans of the rail transit agencies they oversee
