UTA Public Ordinance Update

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 17B-1-301 and 17B-2a-808; A board of trustees of a large public transit district may:

- Make and pass ordinances, resolutions, and orders that are:
 - Not repugnant to the United States Constitution, the Utah Constitution, or the provisions of this part; and
 - Necessary for:
 - (A) the governance and management of the affairs of the district;
 - (B) the execution of district powers; and
 - (C) carrying into effect the provisions of this part;

- Review of 2016 UTA Ordinance
- Cross functional review team – fares, legal, public engagement, enterprise strategy, IT, Police and customer service
- Recommendation to separate fare payment, criminal and trespass ordinances

UTA Fare Payment Compliance Ordinance

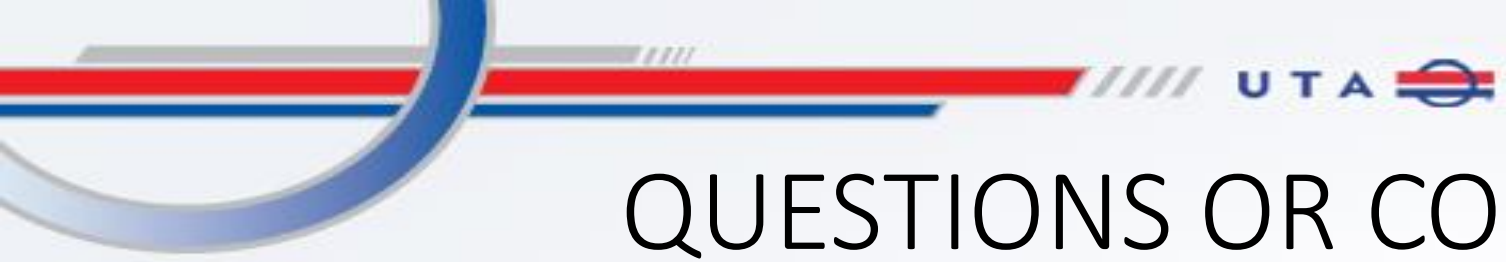
Goals
