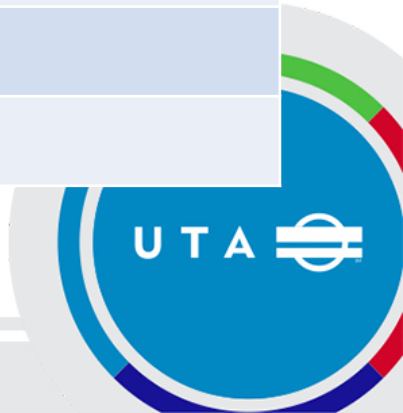

UTA On Demand: Tooele County



Low or No Emission Vehicle Program Grant Tooele MicroTransit

The project will allow UTA to deploy electric vehicles for UTA On Demand microtransit service in Tooele County

Eight light-duty fully electric vehicles and associated charging equipment are funded by the grant

Reduces vehicle emissions by providing clean energy vehicles and an alternative form of transportation

Total Capital Cost: \$1.3 Million

Federal Ask: \$1.1 Million

Local Match: \$200K



UTA On Demand: Tooele County

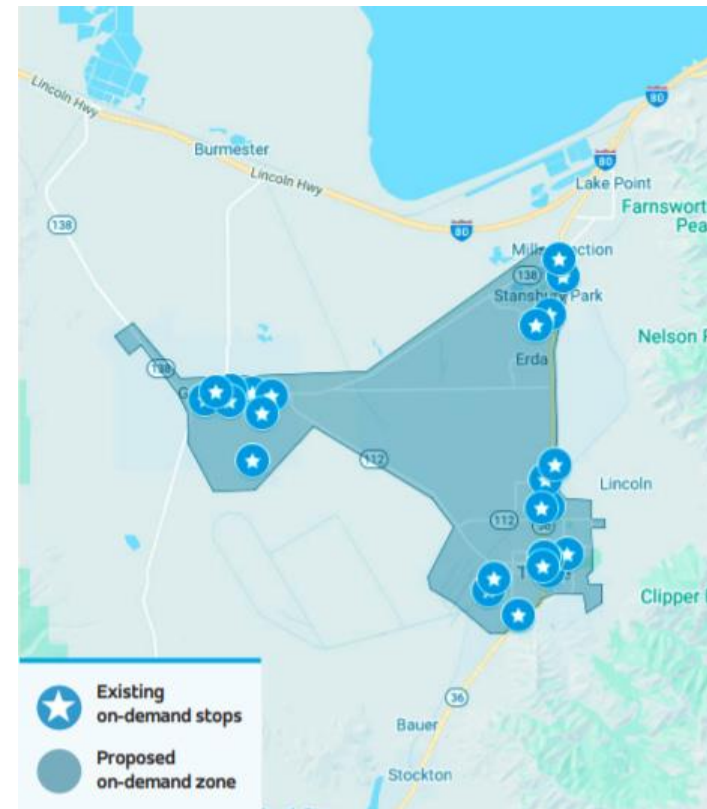
Tooele County was among the highest-ranked zones for microtransit, and has been included in UTA's Five-year service plan

Improves connections between the rural communities of Tooele, Grantsville, Stansbury Park, and express bus to Salt Lake City
