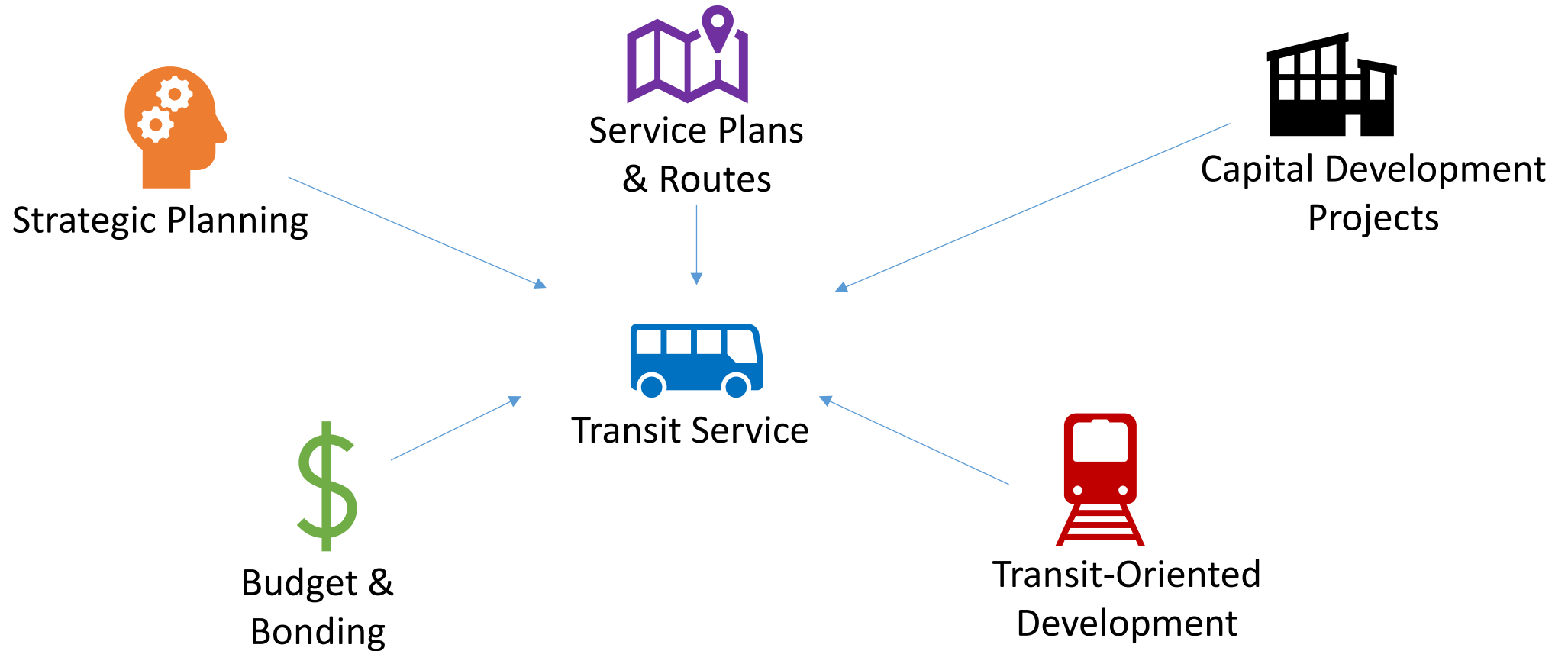

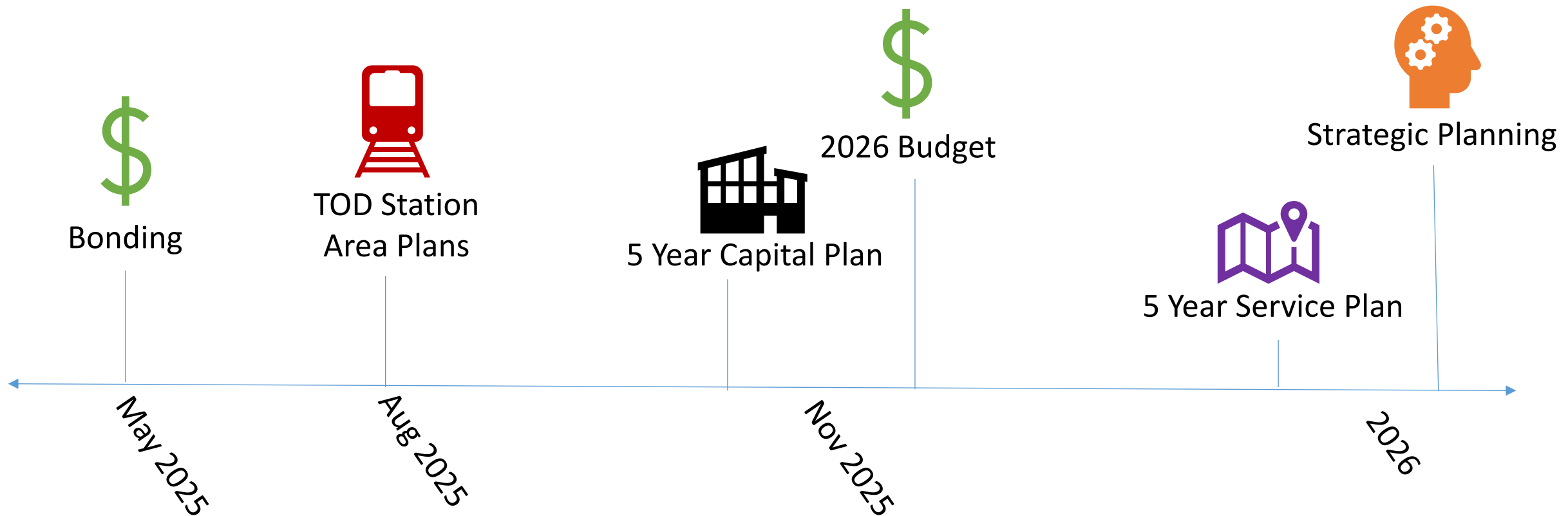
Local Advisory Council Statutory Roles

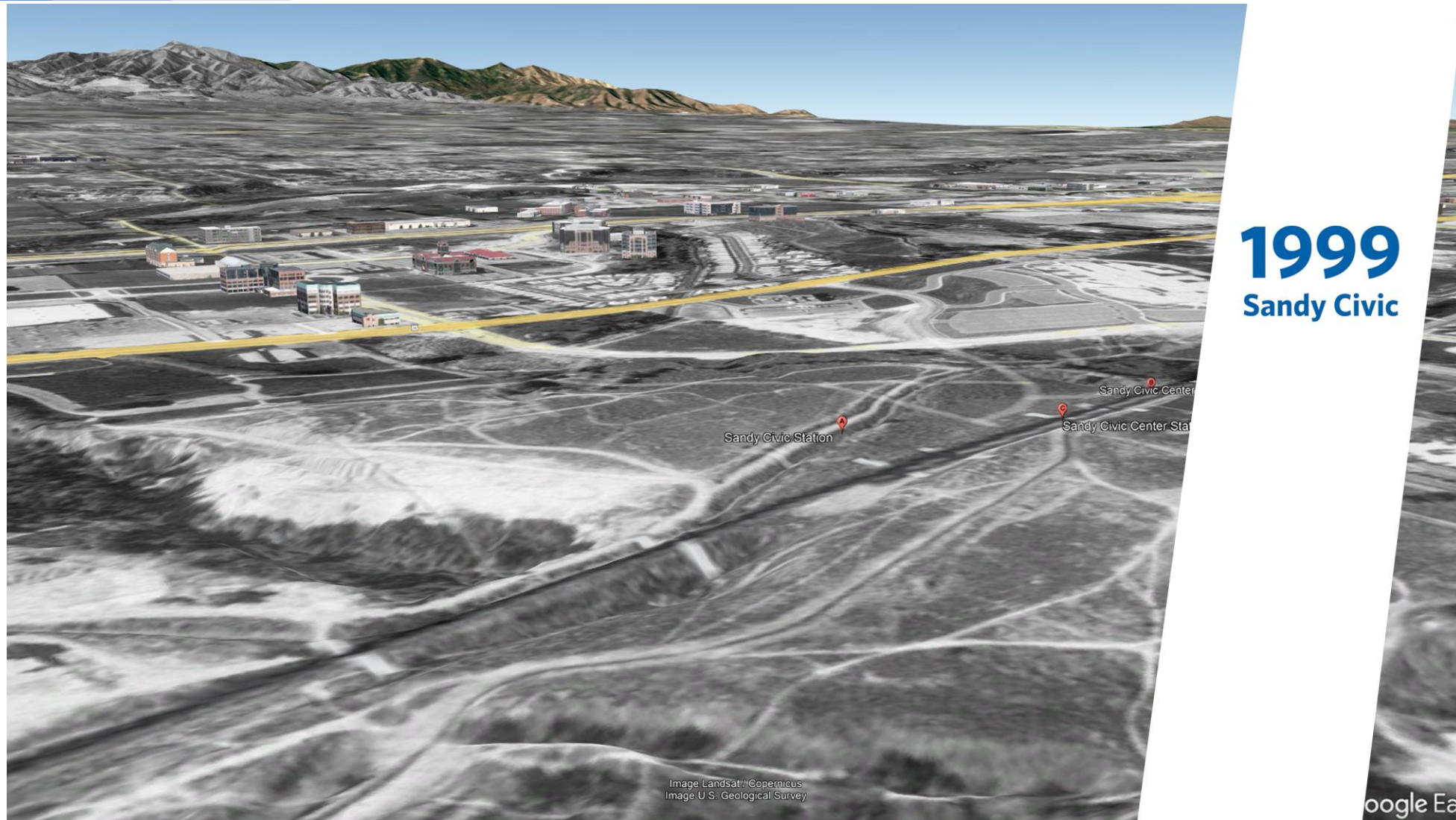
