Zero Emission Plan (ZEP) - Strategic Update

 Ensuring UTA's Zero Emission Bus strategy aligns with agency-wide sustainability and fleet replacement goals

 Leverage federal grant programs to support the transition to low and zero emission buses.

 The current administration has slowed or paused zero emission bus initiatives that previously supported electric bus deployment and related infrastructure.

Plan Inception and Lessons Learned

- 2022 Initial ZEP adopted
- Long term goals transitioning to cleaner fuels
- 50% alternate fuel mix by 2042
- ZEP and 5-Year Service Plan directly inform the Fleet Management Plan how the agency manages its fleet to meet current and future service demands

- Develop updated recommendations
- Focus areas:
 - Strengthen collaboration across departments to ensure coordinated efforts
 - 2. Align initiatives around efficiency and operational reliability for optimal performance
