Total Project Cost = \$1,400,000

\$950,000 RAISE award and \$450,000 local match

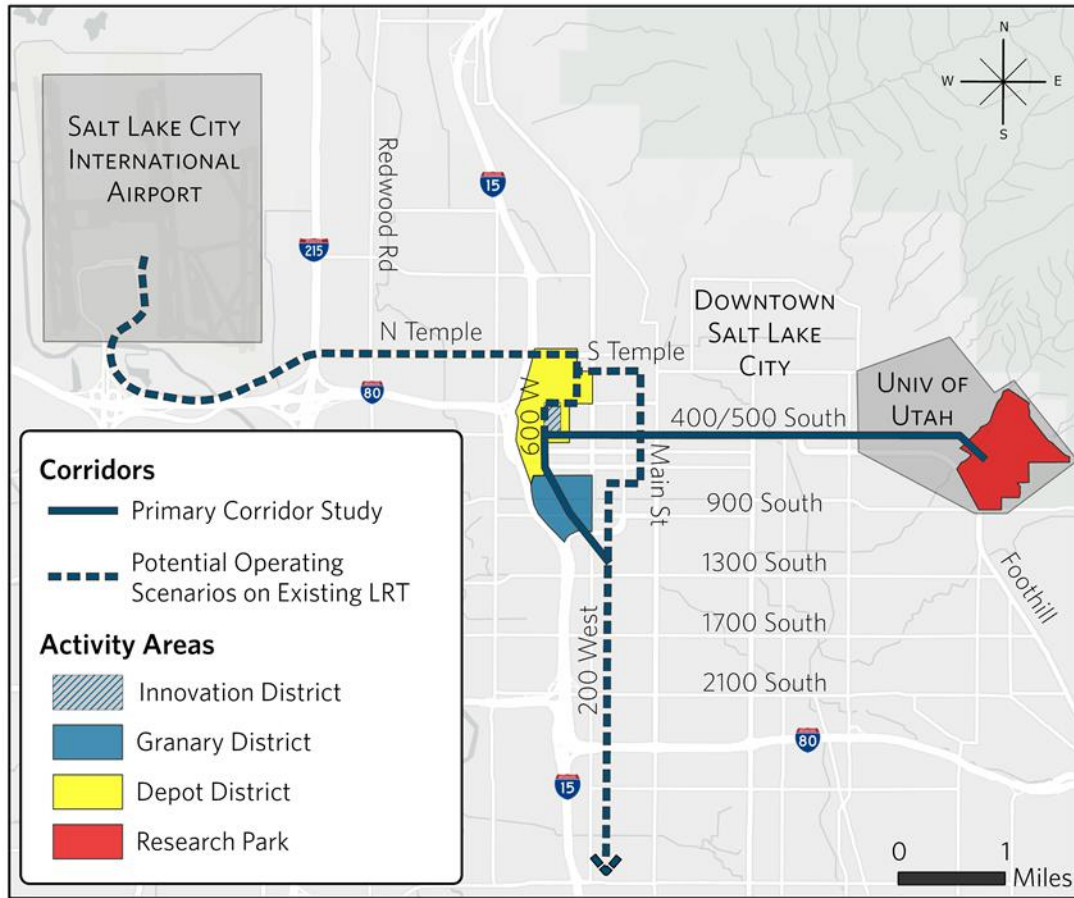
Match requirement is 20%; TechLink is overmatched by 12%

- University of Utah - \$200,000
- Redevelopment Agency of Salt Lake City - \$25,000

TechLink Corridor Study



- Will identify a transit corridor investment for growing neighborhoods on the east and west sides of Downtown Salt Lake City and improve regional connectivity via UTA's TRAX system.
- Will explore new transit connections in Downtown SLC, including a link between the UofU's Research Park and the Innovation District near Salt Lake Central.
- The Innovation District will provide a live-learn-work-play environment where innovation thrives.
- Approximately 157,331 jobs are located within a half mile of the study area.
- The corridor is ripe for redevelopment, including the Granary and Depot Districts and the University's Innovation District.
