

Amendment Three and Reinstatement of
Davis County
SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Amendment 3 to the Service Agreement (this “**Amendment**”) is entered into as of December 7, 2022 (the “**Amendment Effective Date**”) by and between Davis County, (“**Administrator**”) and Utah Transit Authority, a public transit district organized under the laws of the State of Utah (“**UTA**”). Administrator and UTA are sometimes referred to herein collectively as the “**Parties**” or individually as a “**Party**”.

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Administrator and UTA agree as follows:

1. TERM. This Agreement, which expired on March 28, 2022, by this Amendment Three, is hereby reinstated for a new term effective December 7, 2022, and continue in full force until March 26, 2023
2. Article 4. Dates of service shall be December 10, 2022, through March 26, 2023. This includes 85 regular days and 22 peak days for a total of 107 service days.
3. Article 6- (Consideration). UTA shall invoice and Davis County shall pay to UTA the amount of \$43,839. All remaining provisions of Article 6 remain unchanged by this amendment.
4. All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged.
